What is the ESEA Malawi 2025 Programme?

ESEA Malawi 2025, is an accelerator programme which has been designed to support high growth startups in renewable energy, food security and climate adaptation. The programme is being implemented in 5 countries: Malawi, Kenya, Tanzania, Mozambique and Ghana. It provides mentorship, training, access to funding opportunities to help entrepreneurs scale their businesses.

Who can apply?

Startups operating within the thematic areas - Renewable Energy, Food Security or Climate adaptation. They should exhibit potential for growth, commitment to sustainability and willingness to engage in the projects activities including Training and coaching.

Does my business need to be based in Malawi?

Yes, the program primarily targets startups operating in Malawi, though partnerships with regional startups may be considered.



We are looking to support 100 startups. 30 will be selected to participate in intensive investment readiness acceleration programme

What are the benefits for participating?

- Training in investment readiness and business growth
- Mentorship from industry experts
- Linkages to investors through networking
- Access to funding through peer-selected re-grants

What is the peer-selected re-grant process?

During the program, startups will participate in a peer selection process where they evaluate and vote on which businesses should receive funding. Four startups will receive grants of \$25,000 each.

Will participating startups receive direct funding?

Will participating startups receive direct funding? While funding is not guaranteed, the program offers access to investors and capital opportunities, including the peer-selected re-grants and connections to funding partners.
